The United States Postal Service has established a program called "Wee Deliver" to help promote literacy in elementary schools across the nation.

I would like to invite you to participate in our school postal system. The objectives for the program are:

1. To provide children with real-life experiences in which to apply basic skills: addressing envelopes using the mail system; writing a letter using punctuation appropriate for letters; locating street addresses; using zip codes.
2. To unify the entire student body through a student-centered, school-wide communication system.
3. To provide a vehicle for students to use the writing skills learned through the process of writing strategies.
4. To provide knowledge of how mail is processed.
5. To improve literacy skills.

We will begin our postal system on Monday, October 16. Mail may be deposited in the Apison Wee Deliver mailbox in the front hallway by the Music Room.

Students should use their room number, name of their teacher plus Road, Apison, Tennessee 37302 for their address.

Example:

If student's name is Susie Jones and she is in room A10 which is Mrs. Smith's class, her Wee Deliver address would be:

**Miss Susie Jones
A10 Smith Road
Apison, Tennessee 37302**

Stamps may be drawn, stickers, or class stamps may be used for postage.
