

# Hunter Middle School Dressing Guidelines

## 2010-2011

The following expectations for student dress have been established. Apparel and/or appearance that draw attention to an individual rather than to a learning situation must be avoided. Hunter Middle School students are known to be respectful. If an adult in the building asks you to fix your attire (i.e. tuck in your shirt due to inappropriate length), you will be expected to do so. If you do not comply, you are being defiant and disciplinary actions will be taken. **All items must not have anything inappropriate on them. In matters of opinion, the judgment of the principal or his/her designee shall prevail.**

The following dress standards will be observed at Hunter Middle School:

### **Shirts and Blouses**

Students may wear any pattern or color of button down or polo-style shirt. Shirts must have sleeves and buttons. Students may wear Hunter Middle T-shirts. The outer most shirt must be a dress code shirt. NO cleavage may be visible. Only two buttons are to be unbuttoned. Shirts must be size/length appropriate and do not have to be tucked in unless the shirt tail is longer than the hip. If shirt tail is longer than the hip, it must be tucked. Turtlenecks are appropriate.

### **Pants**

Any solid color of pants or jeans is allowed. Students may not wear pajama pants, sweat pants, or jogging pants. Ripped, frayed or torn clothing is not appropriate. There must be NO holes in the clothing. All pants must be worn at the waist.

### **Shorts ,Skirts and Dresses**

Shorts, skirts and dresses must be to the knee. Any solid color or pattern is allowed. Students may not wear athletic shorts, running shorts, spandex, or other inappropriate material.

### **Outerwear**

You may wear lightweight sweaters, Hunter sweatshirts, or lightweight jackets with or without hoods. The hoods may not be worn on your head in the building. Oversized, heavy-weight coats must remain in the lockers.

### **Footwear and Other**

Students may not wear open-toed shoes. No visible piercings other than the ear.
