## Kindergarten Supply List

Your child will need the following items when they come for their first phase-in day.

### 1 School Box (approx. 5" x 8")

This is the perfect size to fit in cubbies! See the one on display!!

### 1 Box of Kleenex

This will be for the whole class to use. You would be amazed at how many runny noses we have through the school year !!

### 2 rolls of paper towels

### 4 - 4 oz. Bottles Elmers School Glue

We have tried many kinds of glue, paste, and glue sticks and have found that Elmer's is the best! Please do not get the kind that says "no run"-it will not come out of the bottle!

### 1 Box of Zipper Ziploc Bags

Boys bring quart size and girls bring gallon size.

### 2 Boxes of Crayola crayons (24 count regular size)

**Even though the children need only 8 crayons at first, the 24 count box is usually the one on sale before school starts. We will use them all eventually anyway! Please write initials on each crayon. We know it sound a little crazy, but it is wonderful when the children drop their crayons on the floor and we know who they belong to!!**

### 2 Tubs of folded Baby Wipes

### 1 Large Back Pack

Your child will need a backpack large enough to hold folders, papers, art projects, etc. **No rolling backpacks.**

### 1 Pair of Fiskars Children's Scissors

Cutting can be quite frustrating for a 5 year old if their scissors don't cut well. Fiskars is the brand that has worked the best. They may be a little more expensive than other brands, but they are well worth the cost!

### 2 #2 Pencils

Regular size pencils normally work fine. If we see that fat pencils work better for your child, we will let you know.

\* Children will need a matching set of supplies at home for completing homework.

\*\*Please keep a set of extra clothing in their backpack in case of accidents. (This keeps

us from having to call you at work!)
